

## **Title IX Resources and Supportive Measures**

A formal Title IX report is not required to receive access to resources, supportive measures, and other remedies. In the event that you would like additional support and resources a pamphlet is available upon request and if you are a full-time employee of Hendrix College, the Employee Assistance Program is available to you. Additionally, you can view a list of contact support services within the community below.

Supportive measures are non-disciplinary, non-punitive individualized services offered as appropriate, as reasonably available, and without fee or charge to restore or preserve access to a Hendrix College education program or activity, including measures designed to protect the safety of all parties or a Hendrix College educational environment, and/or deter harassment, discrimination, and/or retaliation.

These actions may include, but are not limited to:

- Referral to counseling, medical, and/or other healthcare services
- Referral to Employee Assistance Program
- Referral to community-based service providers
- Visa and immigration assistance
- Student financial aid counseling
- Education to the community or community subgroup(s)
- Altering work arrangements for employees or student-employees
- Safety planning
- Providing campus safety escorts
- Providing transportation accommodations
- Implementing contact limitations (no contact orders) between the parties
- Academic support, extensions of deadlines, or other course/program-related adjustments
- Criminal Trespass Warning, Persona Non Grata (PNG), or Be-On-the-Lookout (BOLO) orders
- Timely warnings
- Class schedule modifications, withdrawals, or leaves of absence
- Increased security and monitoring of certain areas of the campus
- Any other actions deemed appropriate by the Title IX Coordinator

Violations of no contact orders will be referred to appropriate student or employee conduct processes for enforcement.
