{2} – Includes \$200 dining dollars (\$100 per semester) for exclusive use in The Burrow or the cafeteria. The 15-meal plan has been replaced with the Board Unlimited option offering extended dining hours.

{3} – Available only for Hendrix Apartment students or off-campus students. No dining dollars are available within this plan.

Under certain circumstances approved by the Office of Student Affairs and Residence Life, some students may be allowed to live in a double room as a single occupant or a triple room with only two occupants. In these cases, the standard rate will be multiplied by 1.5 to obtain the charged amount to that particular student.
